Galapagos Legend carris a maximum of 100 passengers, and also 56 crew, including 7 trained naturalists. Cabins The M/VGalapagos Legend has 53 ocean view, air-conditioned cabins plus 3 interior cabins, with lower beds and private facilities; two double or one matrimonial bed, triple accommodation, interconnecting doors particularly suited for families and friends traveling together. Each cabin includes: safe, entertainment system with LCD TVs, hair dryer, special bedding, and updated furniture. Internal, local and international satellite telephone service is offered, Wi-Fi is accessible when anchoring in main islands. Interconnecting rooms There are interconnecting cabins in all classes of suite and cabin, and also it is possible to add a third bed to most suites. Families Crucially there are several interconnected cabins that are ideal for families with children.

Children can enjoy a wide range of activities on board like stargazing, a visit to the bridge to meet the Captain, Nintendo Wii, handcrafts, and much more. There ia also a special menu for children that will satisfy even the most picky-eater. On family departures there is a kids corner with trained staff and various activities for children
